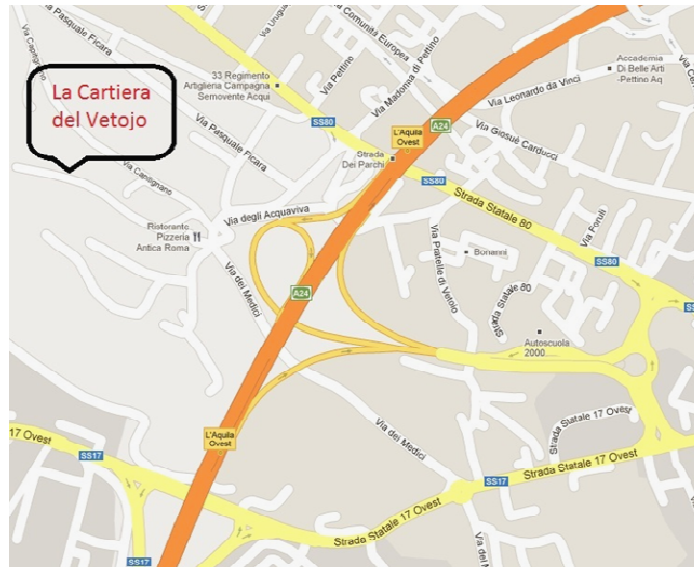

Any school subject is now opening to a "shower" of intersections with other subjects, languages and cultures.

Intersectional learning will add fresh perspectives to traditional choices, empower language acquisition and generate engaging classroom practices and projects.

Liliana Landolfi, Ph.D. (in Applied Linguistics at U.S.C Los Angeles, CA.), is an Associate Professor of English language and linguistics at the University of Naples, L'Orientale, Italy. Her research interests include English in its acquisitional nuances and manifestations. She is the author of several CALL programs, books, and articles. She is currently analysing the impact of Neuro-Linguistic Programming (NLP) in formal contexts of L2 acquisition. *P.Æ.C.E. An Italian-English Corpus based on EFL students (2012a)* and *Behind and Beyond the EFL P.Æ.C.E. Corpus (2012b)* are among her recent publications (Liguori Editore).

Silvana Ranzoli is an experienced teacher (High School; S.I.L.S.I.S, University of Pavia), a free-lance teacher trainer and a textbook writer. Her main interests focus on literary studies, CLIL, paragraph writing, brain-based learning, visualization and multimedia teaching. She has published innovative literature materials for Loescher Editore and Alfa Edizioni.
